- 2016 Community Development Block Grant funding
 - Emerson-Garfield Neighborhood has a total of \$56,299 in funding
 - The minimum amount that can be allocated to a project is \$10,000
- Relevant CDBG projects and funding requests include:
 - Fulcrum's Ash Street Workforce Training station (\$10,000)
 - Collaboration with North Hill Neighborhood for "gateway property" on North Monroe
 - New sidewalks
 - North Monroe Revitalization
 - Emerson Park (for public safety improvements)
 - SNAP hope repair (funds are pooled citywide)
 - West Central Community Center (for a garage or ADA ramp)
