We're asking the neighborhoods to seek support at our September Neighborhood Council mtgs.

With support from District 3 neighborhoods, George will help us craft the project descriptions to be placed in the menu of projects our district is interested in supporting.

- 1) Housing rehab or new construction for low/moderate income individual & families
- \* Single Family Housing -- such as programs the rehab derelict/abandoned houses (similar to the program through Habitat for Humanity
- \* Multi-Family Housing -- expand, rehab or develop
- 2) Child Care -- expand access and capacity for childcare that is affordable to low/moderate income families
- \* Rehab a facility
- \* expand or develop a center
- \* NonTraditional Hours -- accessible during evenings & weekends

- \* Traffic calming projects don't work for CDBG funds
