**Community Frameworks** is a non-profit affordable housing developer here in Spokane. You may be familiar with a few of their projects recently completed in the Emerson Garfield area, including West 315 (315 W Mission Avenue), a 33-unit apartment building, and 1 South Madelia (corner of Sprague and Madelia), a 36-unit multifamily complex including apartment units and townhomes.

Community Frameworks recently purchased 5 lots on W Sinto Avenue between Howard and Washington Streets, with the intent to construct similar housing. The project would have between 42 and 50 units.

Pre-development coordination: On-going Securing Funding: Now through spring 2020 Anticipated Construction Start: Fall 2020 Anticipated Project Lease-up: Fall 2021

Over the last 3 months representative from District 3 neighborhood councils have met to identify priorities for future project proposals for the Neighborhood Community Development program (NCDP). These representatives obtained input from their neighborhood councils. The result is these priorities.

NCDP Priorities Selected at September 27, 2019 District 3 Meeting

We request that these priorities be shared through the RFP process. We understand that the result will be a menu of capital improvement projects from potential community partners, that reflect these priorities.

- 1) Housing rehab or new construction (infill) for low/moderate income individuals and families
- single-family housing (rehab or infill)
- multi-family housing (rehab or infill)

2) Child Care - expand access and capacity for childcare that is affordable to low/moderate income families. Improvements can include:

- rehab a facility
- expand or develop a facility
- facility improvements that will allow non-traditional hours (late nights, early a.m., weekends)
- 3) Senior Services/Centers where they don't currently exist
- North of Wellesley
- Facility Development/Rehab to make services/activities available to seniors
- Adapt existing facilities to provide food services and socializing. For example libraries that have meeting rooms and space not used on a continuous basis.
