Building Stronger Neighborhoods Report from Anne Luttrull:

ONS brochure is being updated so please check with Annica to make sure we are good on what you sent her. I hear that not many neighborhoods are responding to her. CA handbook trainings may be attached to the beginning or ending of regular CA meetings to help out the person who does the trainings.

BSN is looking for ideas on how to encourage participation in the neighborhood councils. Many of them are not well attended. If you have ideas I can take them to the meetings. We will not be purchasing barriers for use by the neighborhoods. We will continue to borrow them from the City (streets dept) as there is no place to store them and the expense of them.

There are no regional trainings to attend rather than going to NUSA. Sometimes going to a NUSA location requires an attendee to have to pay for an additional day of a motel and many layover flights which is hard for them. Boise has a model training they do so we can check into that and see how they do it. CA can do one but it is expensive to operate and plan for. Perhaps Boise would consider helping to put on a tri-state event. We could possibly bring in a speaker from there to present their ideas on this. Local universities may also do trainings on local government and would possibly be willing to help out. This is being checked into.
